## Small Facility Power Purchase Rate (SFPPR)

This rate is applicable to qualified co-generation and small production facilities of not more than 100 kW. Single or three phase service is available at 60kV and standard company voltages

The rate at which the Utility will purchase energy from Qualifying Facilities with a design capacity of 100 kW or less is calculated based upon the amount of diesel generation used in the historical period, updated to reflect the current price of fuel, divided by the number of kWh sold in the historical period.
