2 ALJ DAVIS: On record. Good
3 morning. It is approximately 10:30 on
4 February 16th, 2018 in the Commission's east
5 hearing room in Anchorage, Alaska. This is the
6 time and place set for a prehearing conference in
7 Docket U-18-005, entitled In the Matter of the
8 Tariff Revision Designated as TA30-733 Filed by
9 Cook Inlet Natural Gas Storage Alaska, LLC. This
10 prehearing conference was scheduled by Order
11 U-18-005(1) issued January 19th, 2018.

12 Jeffrey Davis, administrative law judge for
13 the Commission presiding. On the dais with me are
14 Commissioners Jan Wilson and Rebecca Pauli. This
15 conference is being recorded. A transcript will
16 be prepared and available on the Commission's
17 website within the next week.

18 The purpose of this morning's prehearing
19 conference is to establish a procedural schedule
20 as well as to address any other matters that may
21 expedite the orderly conduct of this docket. At
22 this time I would like to take appearances by the
23 parties.

24 ENSTAR -- sorry. CINGSA?

25 MS. SMITH: Moira Smith, vice

1 president and general counsel for Cook Inlet
2 Natural Gas Storage Alaska, LLC, CINGSA.

3 ALJ DAVIS: CINGSA. My apologies.
4 Attorney general?

5 MR. WALLER: Jeff Waller and Janet
6 Fairchild-Hamilton.

7 ALJ DAVIS: And Homer Electric
8 Association?

9 MR. SALZETTI: Mike Salzetti and
10 our attorney Pam Anderson with Perkins Coie is on
11 the phone as well.

12 ALJ DAVIS: So as it stands in
13 Docket U-18-004, the parties adopted a procedural
14 schedule which is also intended to be used in this
15 docket, U-18-005, which also includes an extension
16 of the statutory deadline.

17 Because CINGSA was not a party to -004, does
18 CINGSA consent to the extension of the statutory
19 deadline in U-18-005?

20 MS. SMITH: Yes, Your Honor.
21 CINGSA consents to an extension of the statutory
22 deadline to November 1st.

23 ALJ DAVIS: Attorney general?

24 MR. WALLER: The attorney general
25 also consents to the extension of the statutory

1 deadline.

2 ALJ DAVIS: Homer Electric
3 Association?

4 MS. ANDERSON: Homer Electric
5 consents to an extension of the statutory
6 deadline.

7 ALJ DAVIS: Also in this docket
8 there are -- I guess there was a motion to
9 consolidate made in U-18-004, the previous
10 prehearing conference. And there's also an
11 outstanding motion for intervention by Homer
12 Electric Association.

13 We are going -- the Commission will take the
14 same approach and we will address those whenever
15 we address the procedural schedule in the upcoming
16 order.

17 Are there any -- does CINGSA object to
18 consolidation of these dockets?

19 MS. SMITH: CINGSA does not.

20 ALJ DAVIS: CINGSA does not.

21 Are there any other matters that need to be
22 addressed?

23 MS. SMITH: Just so that the
24 Commission is aware, while -- so that the
25 Commission is aware, CINGSA will file a joint

1 petition or an unopposed petition for entry of a
2 confidentiality order in this docket as well as an
3 unopposed motion for expedited consideration on
4 Tuesday.

5 ALJ DAVIS: Thank you. Anything
6 else?

7 Then we are off record. Thank you.
