


### Alaska Relay Traffic Report





### **IP CapTel Minutes**




- The IP CapTel minutes are paid for by the FCC that benefit Alaska residents that the State of Alaska does not have to pay for through the TRS State Contract.
- Alaska has seen greater than average growth on IP CTS due to the Outreach provided.


### Active Subscribers








### CapTel IP Subscribers

# Equipment Distribution Program – total distributed



Goal – distribute up to 120 devices (CapTel 840/840i/2400i/880i and TTY) annually. Devices are directly related to CapTel/Relay usage.

- 2008 2013: EDP distributed 1 TTY
- Total FY 13-14: 47
- Total FY 14-15: 42
- Total FY 15-16: 22
- Total FY 16-17: 25 (9 Months)
- 4 TTYs distributed in 16-17

Overall total distributed: 136 units

### iPad Pilot Program



ATLA has begun outreach by notifying local agencies about the iPad Distribution program. This includes:
