CINGSA's currently effective ESS agreements were all approved by the Commission in Letter Order L1100561 and are virtually identical as to form. The FSS agreement with ENSTAR is attached as Exhibit JBG-2 as an example.

Q. What is CINGSA's ownership structure?

CENGSA is a wholly owned subsidiary of Alaska Storage Holding Company, LLC A., which is owned 65% indirectly by SEMCO Energy Inc. ("SEMCO") (a wholly owned subsidiary of AltaGas), 26.5% indirectly by Berkshire Halbaway Energy Company ("Berkshire Hathaway Energy"), 4.25% by Cook Inlet Region, Inc. and 4.25% by First Alaskan Capital Parmers.
