1 Q. State your name, title and current employer.

2 A. My name is Jared B. Green. I am President of Cook Inlet Natural Gas Storage Alaska,
3 LLC ("CINGSA"), President of the ENSTAR Natural Gas Company Division of
4 SEMCO Energy, Inc., and President of Alaska Pipeline Company.

5 Q. Describe your professional experience.

6 A. My career to date is comprised of technical, managerial, and executive functions
7 focused on accounting, finance, internal controls, risk management, strategy, and
8 executive leadership within the energy industry. I have significant real world, utility-
9 specific experience overseeing the finance, accounting, financial reporting, and internal
10 controls for AltaGas Ltd.'s ("AltaGas") five utility investments across North America,
11 along with my experience overseeing those functions for AltaGas' gas, power and
12 corporate functions. AltaGas is a publicly traded, leading North American energy
13 infrastructure company with a focus in Canada and the United States. As a member of

1 Q. Please describe CINGSA's agreements with these utility customers.

2 A. All of these customers have 20-year FSS agreements under CINGSA's Tariff. The
3 Maximum Storage Quantity ("MSQ") changes slightly over time for ENSTAR and
4 Chugach, with ENSTAR's MSQ increasing and Chugach's MSQ decreasing. The
5 following table includes the key contract quantities currently in effect:

	Maximum Storage Quantity (Bcf) ¹	Maximum Daily Withdrawal Quantity (facility at 100%-45% MSQ) (Mcf/day) ²
ENSTAR	8.475	91,000
Chugach	1.900	35,000
ML&P	0.500	10,000

7 CINGSA's currently effective FSS agreements were all approved by the Commission in
8 Letter Order L1100561 and are virtually identical as to form. The FSS agreement with
9 ENSTAR is attached as Exhibit JBG-2 as an example.

10 Q. What is CINGSA's ownership structure?

11 A. CINGSA is a wholly owned subsidiary of Alaska Storage Holding Company, LLC
12 which is owned 65% indirectly by SEMCO Energy Inc. ("SEMCO") (a wholly owned
13 subsidiary of AltaGas), 26.5% indirectly by Berkshire Hathaway Energy Company
14 ("Berkshire Hathaway Energy"), 4.25% by Cook Inlet Region, Inc. and 4.25% by First
15 Alaskan Capital Partners.
