Per 3 AAC 52.320(d), Each intrastate interexchange carrier shall notify the commission as soon as reasonably possible of any outage defined in 47 C.F.R. 4.5(a) that requires reporting to the Federal Communications Commission under 47 C.F.R. 4.9(b) or any outage that does not meet this threshold that causes a *toll trunk* outage of at least eight hours in duration. The notification must include

- (1) the date and time of onset of the outage;
- (2) the geographic areas affected by the outage; and
- (3) cause of the outage and estimated restoration time, if known.
