Dear Mr. Chicas:

This letter is to inform you that the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (Commission) rejects the tariff revision of Wide Voice, LLC (Wide Voice) designated as TA2-762, filed April 19, 2018. The filing does not comply with the Commission's form and filing requirements,¹ failing to include all information required by 3 AAC 48.270 (a)(2), (3), and (6). Specifically, it does not set out:

- The statutes, regulations, or Commission order that the filing was made under;
- A list of the tariff sheets, special contracts, agreements, forms, or other documents required by Commission order that were filed; and,
- An explanation demonstrating good cause showing why the early effective date is necessary.

Unless the filing is supplemented by May 1, 2018, the Commission will close the tariff advice file and return the filing to you. Should Wide Voice choose to correct the deficiencies, the 45-day review period will begin once the filing fully complies with the Commission's form and filing regulations.²

² AS 42.05.411(a) for 45 day filings that provides that a public utility may not establish or place in effect any new or revised rates, charges, rules, regulations, conditions of service, or practices except after 45 days' notice to the commission and 30 days' notice to the public.
