Dear Mr. Pavilla:

On May 30, 2018, the Commission reminded Atmautluak Joint Utilities (AJU) its Non-regulated Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Report Form (Fuel Report) was due on May 31, 2018. On June 11, 2018, the Commission received a request from AJU to extend filing its Fuel Report from May 31, 2018 to June 22, 2018.

AJU advised it has to locate information at its office to complete the report. The Commission reviewed the request and determined that an extension should be granted in filing its fuel report. Please note that the failure to file by June 22, 2018, may result in suspension from participation in the PCE program.<sup>3</sup>
