Notice of Utility Tariff Filing

The REGULATORY COMMISSION OF ALASKA (Commission) gives notice that Golden Valley Electric Association, Inc. (GVEA) filed TA315-13, proposing to create a new rule, Rule 22, to address disconnection of electric service. Currently, provisions for disconnection of electric service are addressed in Rule 6 and Rule 9 of GVEA's tariff. GVEA proposes creating Rule 22 to specifically address disconnection of electric service.

In addition, GVEA proposes a number of revisions to its provisions for disconnection of service. GVEA proposes specific provisions for reasons for disconnections without notice, expanding its provisions for reason for disconnections with notice, and expanding its general policy for notice of disconnection to include situations where the provision does not apply.

GVEA proposes to introduce new tariff provisions addressing notice of disconnection to certain members who qualify for longer notice periods, notice of disconnection when landlord-tenant relationships exists, and limitations on GVEA initiated disconnections. In addition, GVEA proposes to add provisions for its criteria for contacting the utility when a notice of disconnection has been issued to members who have failed to comply with a deferred payment agreement. Finally, GVEA proposes to introduce provisions for limitations on reasons for disconnection in situations for GVEA initiated disconnections.

This notice does not contain all requested revisions and the Commission may approve a rate or classification that varies from those proposed.
