

### Notice of Utility Tariff Filing

The REGULATORY COMMISSION OF ALASKA (Commission) gives notice that Golden Valley Electric Association, Inc. (GVEA) filed TA316-13, requesting approval of a special contract with the University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF). The special contract is for the provision of short-term regulation services to UAF during the commissioning of its new coal/biomass boiler. Regulation services is defined as electric service provided by GVEA to prevent short-term disturbances in power supply that would otherwise affect system voltage and frequency. During the commissioning process, UAF will continue to use its current boilers to meet its own load requirements and will rely on GVEA for the contracted regulation services.

The special contract provides that UAF shall at all times be liable for and obligated to pay GVEA for the costs which GVEA incurs in providing such regulation services that are in excess of the costs that otherwise would be incurred so as to ensure that there is no negative financial impact to GVEA's Members as a result of GVEA providing regulation services to UAF. To the extent that the amount of regulation requested by and/or provided to UAF in any given day falls within GVEA's scheduled available and actual available regulation (such that providing regulation services to UAF does not result in GVEA having to incur any additional costs), UAF will not be charged for the regulation services provided by GVEA on that particular day. On the occasion that GVEA incurs increased fuel costs in order to accommodate UAF's regulation service, UAF will be charged for and required to pay the actual costs incurred by GVEA in connection with meeting UAF's regulation service.

This notice does not contain all requested revisions and the Commission may approve a rate or classification that varies from those proposed.
