ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY TIMELINE

BY THE COMMISSION:

Background

We initiated this docket to establish procedures and evaluation criteria that would apply when a telecommunications carrier requests designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) in Alaska.¹ After receiving comments on appropriate procedures and criteria, we formulated proposed regulations addressing the process for obtaining and maintaining designation as an ETC in Alaska² and invited comment on the proposed regulations.³ We also held a workshop and public hearing to address mapping and ETC service area description requirements.⁴ At public meetings held May 2, 6, and 7, 2008, we considered comments and revised our ETC proposal. We voted to

Discussion

When we initiate a rulemaking proceeding, the statute requires the issuance of a final order no later than 730 days from the date of the initiating order.⁵ We issued our initiating order in this docket on May 31, 2006, and the statutory timeline for completing this docket expires May 30, 2008 absent extension.

Applicable statutes also provide us with the right to extend the timeline for a period of up to 90 days based on a good cause finding.⁶ At the May 7, 2008 public meeting we noted that extending the timeline in this proceeding would allow us to issue the revised proposal for comment and assist in the development of a complete record, and determined that good cause exists to extend the statutory timeline for this docket.⁷ Accordingly, we voted to extend the statutory timeline in this docket for 90 days.⁸ This order formalizes that decision.
