ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY TIMELINE

BY THE COMMISSION:

We opened this docket to investigate the need for new regulations governing the regulatory treatment of grant-funded plant for rural electric, water, and wastewater utilities subject to our jurisdiction.¹

As the statutory timeline² in this proceeding expires on October 5, 2006, for good cause and as authorized by AS 42.05.175(f) we extend the statutory timeline for ninety days from October 5, 2006 to January 3, 2007. This regulation project had been administered by a commissioner whose term ended before new regulations
