

NOTICE OF UTILITY TARIFF FILING


The REGULATORY COMMISSION OF ALASKA (Commission) gives notice that CHUGACH ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, INC. (Chugach) has filed tariff revision TA380-8, in which it proposes to revise its fuel adjustment mechanism to include the recovery of costs associated with a standardized Firm Compression and Delivery Service Agreement with Kenai Nikiski Pipeline, LLC for natural gas compression. Natural Gas compression is required to allow bidirectional flows on the Cook Inlet Gas Gathering System. The annual recurring compression charge is estimated to be \$0.9 million, or approximately 0.3 percent of 2013 projected retail and wholesale revenue. Chugach has requested the proposed tariff revisions become effective November 1, 2013.

This notice does not include all proposed revisions. The Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from that proposed.
