

**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF
THE REGULATORY COMMISSION OF ALASKA**

On October 7, 2013, the REGULATORY COMMISSION of ALASKA (Commission) issued a public notice of proposed regulations for adoption in Title 3 of the Alaska Administrative Code dealing with demand charge billing for self-generating customers. A brief summary of the proposed regulation change was included in the October 7, 2013, notice. The proposed regulation under consideration in Docket R-12-006 was issued in Order R-12-006(3).

This is a SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE adding to the NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES issued on October 7, 2013. The Commission is providing this SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE to accommodate additional comments filed after the close of the previous comment period, possibly due in part to a broken link on the electronic publication of the notice on the Commission's website.

The October 7, 2013, notice stated that the proposed regulation changes address demand charge billing, including the following:

The proposed regulation, 3 AAC 52.442, would prohibit a utility from billing a self-generating customer for a demand charge incurred during the period of a forced outage required to resynchronize the customer and utility generation following a utility system outage.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to the Regulatory Commission of Alaska at 701 W. 8th Avenue, Suite 300, Anchorage, Alaska 99502. After the public comment period ends, the Regulatory Commission of Alaska will either adopt its proposed regulations or other provisions dealing with the same subject, without further notice, or decide to take no action on them. The language of the final regulations may be different from that of the proposed regulations. YOU SHOULD COMMENT DURING THE TIME ALLOWED IF YOUR INTERESTS COULD BE AFFECTED.
