

## Notice of Utility Tariff Filing

The REGULATORY COMMISSION OF ALASKA (Commission) gives notice that McGrath Light and Power Company (MLPC) filed tariff revision TA139-44, proposing to add a new Auto Pay program and updating the rule and fee for a payment that fails due to nonsufficient funds.

MLPC's proposed Auto Pay program permits customers to sign up to pay their bill via automatic withdrawal from a designated checking or savings account. MLPC proposes that customers may sign up for the Auto Pay program by submitting the "Consumer Authorization for Direct Payment via ACH" form and may discontinue auto pay by submitting the "Cancellation of Automatic Payment" form. MLPC states that there are no fees for initiating or cancelling participation in the Auto Pay program.

In addition to proposing the new Auto Pay program, MLPC proposes adding a new non-recurring charge of \$29.00, for payments which fail due to nonsufficient funds. MLPC states that this charge would apply to checks returned for nonsufficient funds as well as automatic payments that fail due to an insufficient balance to cover the amount of the Auto Pay debit.

This notice does not contain all revisions and the Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from that proposed.
