Dear Ms. Hall:

This letter is to inform you that the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (Commission) rejects the tariff revision of GCI Communication Corp. (GCI) designated as TA580-489, filed November 14, 2016. The filing does not comply with the Commission's form and filing requirements as established by applicable regulations.¹ The filing deficiencies are explained below.

The tariff advice letter does not include all information required by 3 AAC 53.243(d).² Specifically, it does not set out:

- A statement that the filing is submitted under 3 AAC 52.243; and
- A working link to the notice required under 3 AAC 53.243(d)(1).

Unless the filing is supplemented by November 23, 2016, the Commission will close the tariff advice file and return the filing to you. Should GCI choose to correct the deficiencies, the tariff revision may not take effect until the filing fully complies with the Commission's form and filing regulations.³
